Pursuant to Article 19, paragraph (2) of the Law on the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH", 1/94, 8/95, 58/02, 19/03, 2/06, and 8/06), in connection with Article 17 of the Regulation on the Criteria for Calculation and Payment of Fees for Products which after Use Become Packaging Waste and Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment ("Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH", No. 104/22), the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at its 357<sup>th</sup> session held on 6 April 2023, adopts

## **DECISION**

## ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COORDINATION COUNCIL FOR MONITORING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ORDINANCE ON PACKAGING AND PACKAGING WASTE MANAGEMENT

I.

This Decision establishes and regulates the work of the Coordination Council for Monitoring the Implementation of the applicable Ordinance on Packaging and Packaging Waste Management (hereinafter: the Coordination Council).

II.

The Coordination Council shall consist of one representative each from the following entities:

- Federal Ministry of Environment and Tourism,
- Federal Ministry of Finance,
- Federal Administration for Inspection Affairs,
- Environmental Protection Fund of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
- System Operators holding a permit issued by the Federal Ministry of Environment and Tourism.

III.

The members of the Coordination Council are appointed for a period of four years.

The Coordination Council shall hold meetings at least four (4) times per year.

Administrative support for the work of the Coordination Council and the financial resources necessary for its operation shall be provided by the Environmental Protection Fund of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

At its first constitutive meeting, the Coordination Bod Councily shall adopt its Rules of Procedure.

IV.

The Coordination Council shall review the progress of the waste management system, investments in the development of sorting and recycling capacities, periodic and annual financial reports of the system operators as prescribed in the form set out in Annex 2 to the Regulation on the Criteria for Calculation and Payment of Fees for Products which after Use Become Packaging Waste and Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment ("Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH", No. 104/22), as well as annual reports of authorized system operators for waste management, reports of the Federal Administration for Inspection Affairs, and reports of the Environmental Protection Fund of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Through the Federal Ministry of Environment and Tourism, the Coordination Council shall submit an annual report to the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina on the activities carried out, in particular:

- the number of meetings held,
- the topics discussed at the meetings, and the conclusions and recommendations made by the Coordination Council,
- information on the development of the system (number of obligated parties included through system operators and the Fund, number of packaging waste collectors included in the system, quantities of packaging waste delivered for recycling and recovery, educational and promotional activities implemented, investments in infrastructure for system development implemented by system operators and the Fund, and activities carried out by the inspection).

The report shall be submitted no later than by the end of June of the current year for the previous year.

VI.

The Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina shall, by a separate decision, appoint the members of the Coordination Council, consisting of one representative each of the entities referred to in Item II of this Decision, whereby each authorized operator shall have one representative.

VII

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the "Official Gazette of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina."
