Pursuant to Article 19, paragraph (3) of the Law on the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH", 1/94, 8/95, 58/02, 19/03, 2/06, and 8/06), the Decree on the Manner of Establishing and Determining the Amount of Remuneration for the Work of Working Bodies Established by the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Heads of Federal Civil Service Authorities ("Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH", 48/14, 77/14, 97/14, and 58/15), the Decision on Establishing the Coordination Council for Monitoring the Implementation of the Ordinance on Packaging and Packaging Waste Management ("Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH", No. 46/13), the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at its 135th and 136th sessions held on 18 January 2018 and 25 January 2018, adopts

DECISION

ON THE APPOINTMENT OF THE COORDINATION COUNCIL FOR MONITORING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ORDINANCE ON PACKAGING AND PACKAGING WASTE MANAGEMENT

I.

The Coordination Council for Monitoring the Implementation of the Ordinance on Packaging and Packaging Waste Management (hereinafter: the Coordination Council) is hereby appointed, consisting of:

- 1. **Margareta Krešić**, Chair Environmental Protection Fund of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
- 2. **Ejub Salkić**, Member Federal Administration for Inspection Affairs,
- 3. **Jasmin Osmanović**, Member "Eko život" d.o.o. Tuzla, Authorized System Operator for Packaging and Packaging Waste Management,
- 4. **Amela Hrbat**, Member "Ekopak" d.o.o. Sarajevo, Authorized System Operator for Packaging and Packaging Waste Management,
- 5. **Dunja Petrušić**, Member Federal Ministry of Environment and Tourism.

II.

The members of the Coordination Council are appointed for a period of four years.

III.

For their work and engagement in the above-mentioned tasks, the members of the Coordination Council shall be entitled to a monetary remuneration, which shall be provided by the Environmental Protection Fund of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

IV.

As of the day this Decision enters into force, the Decision on the Appointment of the Coordination Council for Monitoring the Implementation of the Ordinance on Packaging and Packaging Waste Management ("Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH", 45/13, 93/14, and 90/16) shall cease to be valid.

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption and shall be published in the "Official Gazette of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina."
